The SMS program is an anonymous and non-punitive safety reporting program that will allow the ISP Airport Management and Safety Team to review all safety reports that are filed and allow the Safety team to work to mitigate these problems if they arise.

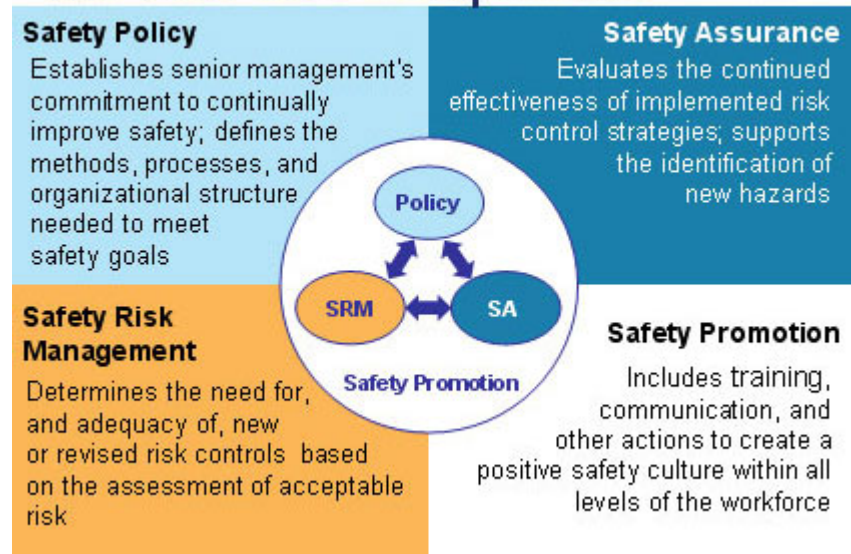
The

overall goal of the SMS program is to create a safer environment for all employees and tenants alike; it will also allow the ISP Safety Team to identify safety concerns if a trend is identified. The SMS program will be in an implementation period from the Spring of 2024 to the Spring of 2025.
